
Kinds of questions


- > Which school district is this house in?

- What kinds of businesses are located in this part of town?











- Combine with GPS, handheld devices, remote sensing imagery




Feature classes

- polygon feature class for lakes


Spatial references


- Geo-referenced data

- Data can be downloaded




